While every effort will be made to ensure the safety of the Heybridge Basin 'Round the Island' Sponsored Row Race, the Heybridge Basin Regatta Association and its agents accept no liability for any damage to property, or death or injury, howsoever arising in connection with the Race.

Parking at the lockside and launching of boats is entirely at the owners risk. No responsibility can be accepted by the Heybridge Basin Regatta Association or the land owners. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or curtail the Race, or exclude any competitor, in the interests of safety, according to conditions on the day.

General Guidance

Safety and Insurance

Competing Craft

- a) All entrants are responsible for the safety and condition of their own craft and equipment and for insuring it and that insurance must include adequate cover against third party claims for any loss, injury, or damage to property or persons (including all persons aboard the craft). Accordingly, please note that it is a Warranty of the Heybridge Basin Regatta Association's insurance that: all competitors and rescue boats should carry public liability/third party insurance with an indemnity of £2,000,000 minimum.
- b) It is strongly recommended that all boats competing in the 'Round the Island' Race do carry sufficient adequate buoyancy aids for all persons aboard.
- c) Any persons under 16 years of age aboard a boat competing in the 'Round the Island' Race must have a buoyancy aid available to be worn at the discretion of the compulsory responsible adult in charge, or to be put on immediately on instruction from a Race marshal. Under 16 paddlers must wear buoyancy aids at all times.
- d) If your craft is immobilized for any reason – and you need urgent assistance – a member of crew should cross and uncross arms above his/her head and if possible wave a piece of white clothing. Remember that each competing craft is responsible for the consequences of its own navigation.
- e) Competitors are requested to give consideration to the requirements of other river users and whenever changing course you must watch out for oncoming vessels and overtaking vessels and take extra care not to obstruct their progress.
- f) No inflatable dinghies are permitted to take part in the race.

Patrol/Safety boats

There will be a number of safety/patrol boats on the course including a lead boat and a tail boat.

I have noted the Disclaimer and agree to follow the Association's General Guidelines as detailed above understanding that the Association cannot be held responsible for my failure to do so.
